Find file formats that support your learning


How do you prefer to engage with digital learning content? Do you read on your phone or tablet, use a screen reader, like to annotate and highlight, or listen to an audio version? Ally automatically generates "Alternative formats" from your original course files, and makes them available for download so that you can engage with course content in a way that works best for you.

Find Ally's "Alternative formats" where you access your course files or content.

Select your file from "Files" and find Ally "Alternative Formats" in the bar at the top.

Hover over the document in "Files" and select the gear or arrow icon to the right.

Select the arrow icon where files are embedded in your course, such as on a "Page" or in a "Discussion."
