What enhancements or new features are planned for Ally? Will there be any Al enhancements?



Question 2

I know in the past the feedback has been that there were some technical challenges to writing the alt text into the HTML. If that is still a limitation, can you explain what the limitation is? Is there something that is needed from Canvas to enable that to happen?

Answer: First, it is important to highlight the difference between Standalone Images and Images embedded within WYSIWYG content. For standalone images, the LMS does not provide a field to store the alt text. We have looked at a few options, but complexity is introduced when considering all places where a standalone image is used in addition to the files area.



Number of Courses Displayed in The Institutional Report

In some LMSes like Learn, Courses can be configured so they could take date ranges from two terms. Continuous terms is an example of this scenario.


Selecting an academic year in the Institutional Report (for example 2020-21) will consider all courses from all the terms that can be "overlaid" on the same dates:

On the other hand, if you access the Courses tab, you can only select Terms. And it will only show the courses related to the specific term, not to the academic year

Data from old courses


How often if at all does content in older courses change?
